

Randolph Mountain Club hike. Leader: Bill Minifie (466-2938). Mt. Moosilauke (4802 ft.). This beautiful above treeline summit will be reached after a fairly strenuous climb of 2500 feet via the Gorge Brook Trail from the Ravine Ledge Road. Look carefully near the summit; some of Moosilauke's famous mountain cranberries may be ripe. Descend the Carriage Road, Snapper Trail, & Gorge Brook Trail to the starting point. Round trip 7.5 miles. To reach this trailhead from Randolph, take US 2, NH 115, US 3/1-93 (to North Woodstock), NH 112 (West), NH 118 to Ravine Ledge Road (on right). Meet at Appalachia at 8:30 a.m. No rain date. Children must be accompanied by an adult specifically responsible for them.
