**The Randolph Planning Board will hold a Series
of 5 Public Hearings
7:00 pm on Thursday, January 2, 2014 at the
Randolph Town Hall**

The first hearing, starting at 7:00 pm, will consider a draft of a proposed amendment to the Land-Use Ordinance which would revise and establish new requirements for the issuance of drive-way permits. If approved, the amendment would be placed before the Town at Town Meeting.

The second hearing, starting at 7:15 pm, or upon the conclusion of the first hearing whichever is later, will consider a draft of a proposed amendment to the Land-Use Ordinance which would establish requirements and institute a permitting process for demolition activities. If approved, the amendment would be placed before the Town at Town Meeting.

The third hearing, starting at 7:30 pm, or at the conclusion of the second hearing whichever is later, will consider a draft of a proposed amendment to the Land-Use Ordinance which would rearrange and revise existing provisions relating to signs and institute a permitting process for the erection of signs. If approved, the amendment would be placed before the Town at Town Meeting.

The fourth hearing, starting at 7:45 pm or at the conclusion of the third hearing whichever is later, will consider a proposed amendment to the Forest ordinance which would authorize the Planning Board to appoint up to three alternate members of the Forest Commission. If approved, the amendment would be placed before the Town at Town Meeting.

The Fifth hearing, starting at 8:00 pm or at the conclusion of the fourth hearing whichever is later, will consider the draft of the budget for the Forest Revolving Fund for fiscal 2013-2014.

Copies of the proposed amendments and the Forest Fund Budget are filed with the Randolph Town Clerk, are on the Town Web Site and are posted at the Town Hall.
